Wilson and Elects Wilson, his wife, to John O. Mitchell, and J.E. Crossie, dated June 10, 1912, and recorded in book 128, at page 324, in the office of the County Olerk of the said county of Fulse, State of Oklahoma, and subject to the essement of eight '8) feet of/one hundred (100) feet as described in said deed.
