accrued obligation. The lessee may be required by the Secretary of the Interior, or by such officer as may be designated by him for the purpose to drill and operate wells to offset wells on adjoining tracts, and within three hundred deet of the dividing line, or in case gas wells lessee may have the option, indieu ofdrilling effsets, of paying a sum equal: to the royalties which would accrue on each well to be offset if said wells had been drilled and were being operated on the land described therein and in accordance with the terms hereof. It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that offset wells shall be drilled or royalty paid in lieu of drilling within ten days after the lessee is notified to do so, and failure to comply with such requrements shall consitute a violation of one of the substantial terms of this lesse.

The lesseeshall carry on developments and operations in a workmablike manner, commit no waste on the said land and suffer none to be committed upon the portion in his occupancy or use, take good care of the same and promptly surrender and returm the premises upon the termination of this lease to lessor or to whomsoever shall be lawfully entitled thereto, unaviodable casualties excepted; shall not remove therefrom any ouildings or permanent improvements erected thereon, during the said term by the said lessee, but said bildings and improvments shall/remain a partual said land and become the property of athe owner of the land as a part of the consideration for this lease, excepting tools, derricks, boiler /houses, pipe lines, pumping and drilling outfits, tanks, engines and machinery, and the casing of all dry or exhausted wells which shall remain the property of the lessee, and may be fellowed at any time prior to sixty days offer the termination of the lesse by forferture or otherwise; and shall not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under lessee's control nor allow shy intoxicating laquors to be sold or given way for any purpose on such premises; shell not use such premises for any other purpose than those author ized in the lesse; and before abendoning any well shall securely plug the same so as effectually to shut off all water from the oil-bearing stratum or in the manner required by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

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- 6. The lessee shall keep an accurate account of all oil-mining cerations, showing the sales, prices, dated, purchases, and the whole amount of oil mined or removed; and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on all implements, tools, movable machinery, and all other personal chattels used in operating said property, and also upon all of the unsold oil obtained from the land herein lessed, as security for payment of said royalty.
- 7. The lesses may at any time, by paying the Superintendent for the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskoges, Oklahoma all amounts then due as provided herein and the further sum of one dollar, surrender and cancel this lesse and be relieved from all further obligations or liability thereunder Provided, if this lesse has been recorded lesses shall execute a release and record the same in the proper county recording office: Provided, further, in event restrictions are removed from all lessed premises, the lesses may surrender all the undeveloped portion thereof by paying the lessor all amounts then due and the further sum of one dollar, which surrender shall not affect the terms hereof as to each producing well and square tensores or said premises as nearly in/form assippossible next contiguos to and surrounding each of said wells, and execute and record a cancellation of premises surrendered.
- 8. This lesse shall be subject to the regulations of the Secretary of the Interiorm now or hereafter in force, relative to such lesses, all of which regulations are made a part of this lesse. Provided, however, that no regulations made after the approval of this lesse, affecting either the length of term of oil and gas lesses, the ratesof royalty or payment thereunder. Of the assignment of lesses, shall perste to affect the terms and conditions of this lesse.
