ORDINANCE NO. 2566.

An ordinance adding and annexing to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land within Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the intersection of the north line and the north and south center line of section 13, township 19-north, range 12 east, thence south along said center line a distance of four hundred and forty six and four tenths (446.4) feet to its intersection with the easterly line of the Midland Valley Railroad Right of Way, thence west along a line parallel to and four hundred and forty six and four tenths (446.4) feet south of the said north line of section 13, to the westerly line of
