Beginning on the center line of Elwood Avenue and the center line of Fifteenth Street, ~~thence south along the center line of Fifteenth Street~~; thence south along the center line of Elwood Avenue to the intersection thereof with the easterly extension of the north line of lot 2 in Block 1 of Riverford addition; thence west along the north line of said lot to the west line of said lot; thence south along the west line of said lot 2 and 3 in said block 1 to the south line of said lot 3, thence east along said line of said lot 3 to the center line of Elwood Avenue; thence south along the center line of Elwood Avenue to the center line of Buena Vista Place; thence west along the center line of the extension thereof, to the east bank of the Arkansas River; thence northwesterly along the easterly bank of the Arkansas River to the northwest corner of said Riverford addition; thence east along the north line of said addition to the place of beginning, ~~be and the same are hereby annexed to the City of Tulsa.~~

be and the same are hereby annexed to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and that the corporate limits of said City be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described tracts of land.

Section 2. That from and after this ordinance takes effect, the real estate described and bounded in section one hereof shall be and the same is hereby declared to be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon shall be and ~~are~~ hereby declared to be subject in all respects ^{and particularly} to the jurisdiction control and laws and ordinances of said City of Tulsa.

Section 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
