4. That the Grantee shall pay all damage to femes, crops and premises, which may be suffered by reasonof, makehance, operation or alteration of said lines of pipe. If not mutto be asculated and destinated by the distributed pure through and destinated by the whor of the premises, one by the Grantee, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of two of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

This centract shall bind and rup in favor of the respective parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.
