Braden, deceased, at the time of his death, and also, all the right, title, and interest that the said estate by operation of law, or otherwise may have acquired other than or in addition to that of said estate, at the time of his death, in and to all the interest of the said G. T. Braden, in and to the two oil and gas mining leases hereinbefore described, and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, including all rents and royalties accruing and accrued.
