This agreement shall bind and run in favor of the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns.

It is agreed by the parties that the lease dated July 3, 1923, made and entered into by the same parties and recorded in book 471, at page 21, of the records of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, be and the same is in all things cancelled.
