ments ereted thereon during the said term bythe said lessee, but said huldings and improvements shall remain a part of said land and become the property of the owner of the land as a part of the consideration for this lesse, excepting tools, derricks, beiler, boiler houses, pipe lines, pumping and drilling outfits, tanks, engines and machinery, and the casing of all dry exhausted wells which shallremain the property of the lessee, and may be removed at any time prior to sixty days after the termination of the lesse by forfeiture or otherwise; and abt permit any nulsance to be mantained bn the premises under lessee's control nor allow aby intoxicating liquors to be sold or givenaway for any purposes onsuch premises; shall not use such premises for any other purpose than those authorized in the lesse; and befor abandoning any well shall securely plug the same so as effectually to shut off all water from the oil-bearing stratum, or in the manner required by the laws of the State of Oklahams.

- 6. The lessee shall keep an accurate account of all oil-mining operations, showing the sales, prices, dated, purchases, and the whole amount of oil mined or removed; and all sums due as royalty shall be a lien on all implements, tools, movable machinery, and all other personal chattels used in operating said property and also upon all of the model oil obtained from the land herein lessed, as security for payment of said royalty.
- Tribes, Muskogee, Oklahoma, all amounts then due as provided herein and the further sum of one dollar, surrender and cancel this lease and be relieved for all forther obligations or liability thereunder; Provided, if this lease has been recorded leases shall execute a release and record the same in the proper county record. Office: Provided, forther, in event restrictions are removed from all leased premises, the lessee may surrender all the undeveloped portion thereof by paying the lessor all amounts then due and the further sum of one dollat, which surrender shall not affect the terms hereof as to each producing well and ten acres of said premises as bearly in square from as possible next contiguous to and surrounding each of said wells, and execute and record a cancellation of premises surrendered.

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- 8. This lesse shall be sbject to the regulations of the Secon of the Interior, now or hereafter in force relative to such besses, all of which regulations are made a part and condition of this lesse; Provided, however, that no regulations made after the approval of this lesse, affecting either the length of term of oil and gas lesses, the rates of poyalty or payment thereunder, or the assignment of lesses, shall operate to affect the terms and conditions of this lesse.
- 9. Upon the violation of any of the substantial terms and conditions of this lease the the Secretary of/Interior (or lessor, in event restrictions are removed as provided in patagraph 12 hereof) shall have the right, stany time after thirty days' notice, to the basee specifying the terms of conditions violated to declare this lease hull and void, and the lessor shall then be entitled and authorized to take immediate possession of the land.
- 10. Before this lesse shall be in force and effect the lessee shall furnish a bond with responsible surely to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior, and such further bond or bond as may be required by said Secretary conditioned for the performance of this lesse, which bond shall be deposited and remain on fine in the Indian Office.
- ll. Assignment of this lease or any interest therein maybe made with the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, it being understood that to secure such approval the proposed assignee need only be qualified to hold such a hense under the rules and regulations, and furnish a bond with resonsible surety to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior, conditioned for the fatthful performance of the covenants and conditions of this lease.
- 12. In event restrictions on alimention shall be removed fromall the leasehold ptemises described above, this lease shall be released from the supervision of the Secretary of the
