WAIVER.

Whereas, on the 20th day of December, 1923, the plaintiff above named obtained a judgement against the above named defendant in the sum of \$2431.21, and costs; and,

Whereas, said case is not pending in the above styled court on a motion for new trial; and,

Whereas, it is the desire of plaintiff to waive his said judgement lien should it become final against certain real estate owned by said defendant.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the sum of one dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, the undersigned, F. B. Jackson, Trustee, plaintiff in the above entitled cause, to hereby release any lien that I may now have or might hereafter obtain by reason of said above described judgement covering the following described real estate and premises situate in Tulsa County, to-wit:
