To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting.

Whereas, by the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat. 716) ratified by the Cherokee Nation August 7, 1902, it is provided that there shall be allotted by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes; to each citizen of the Cherokee Tribe, land equal to value to one hundred and then acres of the average allottable lands of the Cherokee Nation, and

Whereas, it was movided by said Act of Congress that ech citizen shall designate or have designated and selected for him, at the time of his selection of allotment, out of his allotmet, as a homestead, land equal to value to forty acres of the average allottable lands of the Cherokee Nation, as nearly as may be, for which he shall receive a separate certificate, and,

Whereas, the said Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes, or its lawful successor, has certified that the land hereinafter described has been selected by or on behalf of Charles Griffin,s citizen of said tribe, as an allotment, exclusive of land equal in value to forty access of the average allotment lands of the Cherokee Nation, selected as shometead as aforesaid.

Now, therfore, I, the undersigned, Principal Chief of the Cherokee Natim, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by aforesaid actof the Congress of the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Charles Griffin, all right, title and interest of the Cheros Nation and of all other citizem of said Nation, in and to the following described land, viz: The north east quarter of the south east quarter of the northeast quarter and the southeast ten (10) acres, and the north twenty and 34/100 (20.34) acres of lot one (1) of section three (3) township twenty two (22) north and range fourteen (14) east, and the southwest quarter of the south cast quarter of section eighteen (18) township twenty three (23) north and range twenty three (23) east, of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Oklahoma, containing fifty and 34/100 (50.34) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to all the provisions of said Actof Congress.

In witness whereof, I, the setd Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto bet my hand and caused the Creat Seal of soid Nation to be affixed this 23rd day of January, A.D.
