

It is specifically understood by and between the parties hereto that the pumps, and equipment of whatsoever nature furnished, used or employed by the party of the first part shall be and remain the property of the first party unless written bill of sale is given therefor, evidencing any conveyance of title thereto.

This agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect during the period of one year from the date of the beginning of operations of the gasoline pump, and shall be optional with party of the first part to renew said contract for an additional year after the expiration of the first year upon thirty days' notice prior to the expiration of the first year. At the termination of this contract, party of the first part shall have a reasonable time within which to remove from the place installed the said gasoline pump as heretofore provided for, together with any and all other equipment, that might hereafter be placed upon said premises by the party of the first part.

This contract shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, successors, administrators, and assigns of the parties hereto.
