WHEREAS Alice Killer a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, was allotted the following described land to-wit; North half (N2) of Northeast quarter NE4) of section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty (20), North, Range Thirteen (13), East of the Indian Base and Meridian containing 80 acres, more or less, located in Tulsa, County, Oklahoma,

NOW, Therefore, I under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27 1908. ( Public No 140,) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restriction from said described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and *as by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with* simultaneously with the execution of the Secretary of the Interior,
