That the undersigned, James Constantine and Olive Constantine, his wife, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in consideration of the sum of one dollar, (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby transfer, sell, assign and convey unto the Farm and Home Savings and Loan Association of Missouri, mortgagee in a certain mortgage hereinafter fully described, its successors and assigns, that certain lease made and entered into on the 18th day of July, 1922, by and between said James Constantine and Olive Constantine, his wife, as lessors therein and E. M. Brown and C. M.
