COMPARED

DEED OF TRUST.

This deed, made and entered into this 9th day of February, 1924, by and between Marionus Renniers and Anne Renniers, his wife, of Tulsa, Okla. parties of the first part, D
and M. Hughes, Trustee, party of the second part, and the Central Savings and Loan Associa-
tion, of Marshall, Missouri, party of the third part.

Witnesseth, at the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the debt and trust hereinafter mentioned and created and the sum of one dollar to them paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by their presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, the following described real estate, situated in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot two hundred sixty nine (269) of the re-subdivision of lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, ^{and} 15, block one (1) Rodgers Heights Subdivision, in addition to the city of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma

and Certificate number 880, being for $3\frac{3}{4}$ share of "D" stock in the Central Savings and Loan Association, of Marshall, Missouri, and possession of said premises and said shares of stock is now delivered unto the said party of the second part.

To have and to hold the same with all the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said party of the second part and to his successors hereinafter designated, and to the assigns of him and his successors, forever.

In trust, however, for the following purposes, whereas, the said Marienus Renniers and Anna Renniers, have this day made and executed and delivered to the said party of the third part one promisory note of even date herewith, by which they promise to pay to the said Central Savings and Loan Association, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, said note being in words, letters and figures as follows:

NOTE OROBLIGATION.

Tulsa, Okla. February 9th, 1924.

One hundred months after date, for value received, we promise to pay to the Central Savings and Loan Association, of Marshall, Mo., fifteen hundred dollars, this day advanced to me as a loan, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable in monthly installments of seven & 50/100 dollars, each, and the further sum of four & 87/100 dollars per month, for premium on said loan so made to us by said Central Savings and Loan Association, of Marshall, Mo., and we further agree to pay said Association, at the same time, said interest and premium are payable the sum of eleven and 25/100 dollars every month, the sum being the monthly dues on certificate No. 880 of the capital stock of the said Central Savings and Loan Association this day pledged by us as collateral security for the payment of said loan; so advanced to us, and we further agree to pay to the said association, all of the said sums of money, amounting in the aggregate to twenty three & 62/100 dollars, on the first Saturday of each and every month until the said Certificate No. 880 so pledged by us as collateral security, to said loan, shall, according to the By-Laws of the said Association, reach the ultimate or par value thereof, or said loan shall be otherwise sooner canceled or discharged.
