WHEREAS; Annie Dirteater a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit: West Half (W2) of Southwest quarter (SW4) of Southwest quarter (SW4) and Southeast quarter (SE4) of Southwest quarter (SW4) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Twenty-One North (21N), Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing thirty (30) acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now therefore, I under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (Public No-140,) and the regulation prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said subscribed land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
