MINING LEASE

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 18th day of December 1923, by and between E. C. King and Aggie King husband and wife called lessor, and Tulsa County Coal Company of Tulsa, Okla., called lessee.

WITNESSETH, 1. That said lessors, in consideration of the premises and the sum of One Dollar, paid to lessor, by lessee do hereby LEASE unto lessee for prospecting and mining and stripping coal and for three years from the date hereof, the following described tract of land (for purposes hereof considered as one parcel), situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
