

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the undersigned, Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by aforesaid Act of the Congress of the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Clarence Maken all right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, and of all other citizens of said Nation, in and to the following described land, viz: The North East quarter of the South East Quarter of the North West quarter of Section Eleven (11) and the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of the Northeast quarter and the North West Quarter of the North East quarter of the North East quarter and the South East quarter of the North East Quarter of the North East Quarter and the North West quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Nine (9) and the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Oklahoma, containing Sixty (60) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to all the provisions of said Act of Congress.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed this 3 day of Mar., A.D. 1913.
