14. In the event that the Lessee herein embraces two or more persons or corporations, all the covenants and agreements of the Lessee herein shall be the joint and several covenants and agreements of such persons or corporations.

15. That all the covenants and provisions of this indenture shall be binding upon the legal representatives and assigns of the Lessee to the same extent and effect as the same are binding upon said Lesse-----every covenant herein shall inure in favor of and run to the successors and assigns of the lessor, and to each and every company, person or corporation which may hereafter own or be in possession of and operate the property of the Lessor, to the same extent and as fully as though such company, person or corporation were specifically named in this lease in the place and stead of the said Lessor.


