Brewer, her husband, parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Forty-five & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1245.00) in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto J. H. Smith, Owasso, Oklahoma, part of the second part, the following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Northeast quarter (NE4) of Southwest quarter (SW4) and Southwest (SW4) of Northwest quarter (NW4) of Southeast quarter (SE4) and Northwest quarter (NW4) of Southwest quarter (SW4) of Southeast quarter (SE4) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Twenty-one (21) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian- containing Sixty (60) acres, more or less, located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
