248002 C.J. COMPARED ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Fitzpatrick, his heirs and assigns, an undivided one-eighth of all the right, title and interest of the original lessee and present owner in and to the said lease and rights thereunder in so far as it covers the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 6-19-12 with the specific understanding and agreement that this assignment is made subject to the terms and conditions of a certain contract entered into between Mary Oil and Gas Company and J. E. Fitzpatrick, dated November 25th, 1922, and the supplements thereto filed for record in the office of the County Clerk in Tulsa County on the -----day of ----- A.
