ORDINANCE NO. 2561.

COMPALED
An Ordinance adding and annexing to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land, known as BLOCKS 1 and 8, of CHEROKEE HEIGHTS SECOND ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that a certain tract of land known as Blocks 1 and 8, of CHEROKEE HEIGHTS SECOND ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereinafter particularly described, lying in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and lying contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, is surrounded on three or more sides by the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa and abuts on the City of Tulsa on three or more sides, and,

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners
