An Ordinance adding and annexing to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land within Julsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 186 of the Original Townsite of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, accord ing to the duly recorded plat thereof; thence Northeasterly along the South line of said Block 186 a distance of one hundred and thirty-one and four-tenths (131.4) feet to the Southeast corner thereof; thence North along the East line of said Block 186 a distance of three hundred and twenty-six and five-tenths (326.5) feet to the Northeast corner thereof; thence Northeasterly along the North line produced, of said Block 186, to its intersection with a line parallel to and sixty-four and four-tenths (64.4) feet South of the South line of Blocks 11 and 12, of Burnett Addition to the City of Julsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof; thence East along said line parallel to the South line of Blocks 11 and 12, to the Northwest corner of Oaklawn Cemetery; said corner being one thousand two hundred and ninety-five (1,295) feet, more or less, West of the East line of Section 1, Township 19 North, Range 12 East; thence South along the West line of Oaklawn Cemetery, said line being parallel to the East line of said Section 1, to the South line of said Section 1; thence West along said South line to its intersection with the Southeasterly production of the West line of the above described Block 186; thence Northwesterly along said Southeasterly production to the point of beginning, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that the hereinafter described tract of land, situated in Tulsa County,Oklahoma, lies contiguous to and adjoins the present corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on three or more sides. 183

WHEREAS, it further appears to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of said City that the said tract of land hereinafter described abuts said Gity on three or more sides and should be annexed to the City of Julsa and entered within its corporate limits and that said tract of land does not exceed forty acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA;

SECTION 1. That a tract of land abutting on three sides with the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Elock 186 of the Original Townsite of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the duly recorded plat thereof; thence Northeasterly along the South line of said Elock 186 a distance of one hundred and thirty-one and fourtenths (131.4) feet to the Southeast corner thereof; thence North along the East line of said Block 186 a distance of three hundred and twenty-six and five-tenths (326.5) to the Northeast oorner thereof; thence Northeasterly along the North line produced, of said Elock 186 to its intersection with a line parallel to and sixty-four and four-tenths (64.4) feet South of the South line of Elocks 11 and 12, of Burnett Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof; thence East along said line parallel to the South line of Blocks 11 and 12, to the Northwest corner of Oaklawn Cemetery, said corner being one thousand two hundred and ninety-five (1.295) feet, more or less, west of the East line of Section 1, Township 19 North, Range 12 East; thence South along the West line of Oaklawn Cemetery, said line being parallel to the East line of said Section 1, to the South line œ said Section 1; thence West along said South line to its intersection with the Southeasterly production of the West line of the above described Elock 186; thence Northwesterly along seid Southeasterly
