ORDINANCE NO. 2564.

COMPARED

An Ordinance adding and annexing to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land known as HOPPING HEIGHTS ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, that a certain tract of land known as HOPPING HEIGHTS ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereinafter particularly described, lying in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and lying contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of the said City, is surrounded on three or more sides by the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa and abuts on the City of Tulsa on three or more sides, and.

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners that the said tract of land hereinafter described should be added and annexed to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and included within the corporate limits of said City, and it further appears that said tract of land is not in excess of forty (40) acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That a tract of land hereinafter described, the same being known as HOPPING HEIGHTS ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 13 East; thence South along the East line of said Northwest quarter
