PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

COMPARED

Whereas, J. O. Campbell, as mortgagor did under date of October 8th 1920, execute a certain Mortgage, filed for record in the office of the County Clerk, Ex-Officio Register of Deeds in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on October 11th, 1920, which mortgage now appears of record in said office in Book 353, at page 32, and which mortgage was given to Winnie McIntosh, as mortgagee upon the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

For the purpose of securing the payment of certain promissory notes described in said mortgage in the total principal amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars, (\$20,000.00) and

Whereas, a portion of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage has been paid on behalf of the said J. O. Now therefore, the Title Guarantee & Trust Company, Assignee of said Mortgage and the present owner and holder of the above described note, does hereby discharge and release unto the said J. O. Campbell, his heirs and assigns, those lots or sub-divisions of real estate here above described, said subdivision being platted and known as Carbondale, and does hereby release and forever quit claim unto the said J. O. Campbell, his heirs and assigns, all title and interest in and to that portion of said estate hereinafter described as follows, to-wit:

> Lots Five (5) and Seven (7), Block Eight (8), Carbondale, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof,

Providing, however, it is expressly understood and agreed that this Quit Claim shall not be construed as releasing any portion of the real estate as herein first above described, other than those blocks and lots in Carbondale as herein set forth and described.
