ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated November 27, 1922, entered into by and between Sand Springs Home, a corporation, lessee, and William G. Bruner and Esther Bruner Rabey lessors, covering the following described lands in the Creek Nation, Oklahoma;

Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Six (6), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Sand Springs Home, the lessee in the above described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys all the right, title and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to M. W. Thompson of New York City, New York.

This assignment is limited to the oil and gas rights in and under said lands below the top of the Mississippi Lime and is intended to convey all of said oil and gas rights granted by said lease below the top of the Mississippi Lime; and all oil and gas rights above the top of said Mississippi Lime are expressly reserved to the Sand Springs Home.

Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and is made subject to the provisions set out in rider hereto attached.
