An oil pumping station used in connection with the operation of said four-inch oil pipe line, including all buildings, pumps, engines, machinery, storage tanks, distributing tanks,pipes, and all other equipment used or purchased for use in connection therewith, being situated on a tract of land in the West Half of Sec. 17, Twp. 23, R. 11 E., in Osage County, Oklahoma, described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a point 325 feet South of the Northwest corner of Southwest Quarter of said Sec. 17, thence North 425 feet; thence East 672 feet; thence South 224 feet; thence in a Southwesterly direction 704 feet to the place of beginning, containing 5.3 acres, more or less.

An oil pumping station used in connection with the operation of said four-inch pipe line, including all buildings, pumps, engines, machinery, storage tanks, distributing tanks, pipes, and all other equipment, used or purchased for use in connection therewith, said pumping station being situated on a tract of land in the Southwest Fourth of Southeast Quarter of Sec. 7, Twp. 24, R. 10 E. in Osage County, Oklahoma, described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a point 600 feet North and 1468 feet West of the Southwast corner of said Sec. 7, thence due West 580 feet to the center of the stream known as Birch Creek; thence following the meanderings of said stream in a southeasterly direction to a point 160 feet North and 1468 feet West of the Southeast corner of said Sec. 7, thence North 440 feet to the place of beginning, containing approximately 4 acres.

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A two-inch oil pipé line now constructed and built over and across certain lands in Osage County, Oklahoma, situated, lying and extending as follows:

Beginning at a point near the Southwest corner of, and located in the Southwest Fourth of Northwest Quarter of Sec. 17, Twp. 23, R. 11 E., thence extending West across the Section line to a point near the Southeast corner of, and located in the Northeast Quarter of Sec. 18, Twp. 23, R. 11 E., thence extending and continuing due North through and across the East Half of the Northeast quarter of said Sec. 18, and the East Half of East Half of Sec. 7, Twp. 23, R. 11 E., to a point near the Southeast corner of, and located in the Southeast Fourth of Southeast Quarter of Sec. 6, Twp. 23, R. 11 E., thence extending and continuing in a Northeasterly direction through and across said Southeast Fourth of Southeast quarter of said Sec. 6, and the Southwest Fourth of Southwest Quarter of Sec. 5, Twp. 23, R. 11 E.; thence North and East through and across the North Half of Southwest Quarter of said Sec. 5, thence in a Northeasterly direction through and across the Northwest Fourth of Southeast Quarter of said Sec. 5, and the Southwest Fourth of Northeast Quarter of said Sec. 5, to a point North and East of the center of the Southeast Fourth of Northeast quarter of said Sec. 5; thence continuing and extending North and Slightly East through and across the said Southeast Fourth of Northeast Quarter of said Sec. 5, and continuing in the same direction through and across the Northeast Fourth of Northeast Quarter of Said Sec. 5, to a point on the West line of the Midland Valley Railroad Company's right of way in the Northeast corner of said Northeast Quarter of said Sec. 5, the total length of said two-inch oil pipe line being 16,051 feet.

All pipe used or purchased for use in the construction, operation and maintenance of said oil pipe lines and of all lateral and gathering lines constructed for the purpose of transporting oil to said oil pipe lines from the lands and leases adjoining the same and tributary thereto.

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
