SECTION 2. That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in Section 1, hereof shall be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of said City of Thisa Oklahoma.

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health peace and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately, and approved, this 6th day of November, 1923.

WHEREAS, a petition in writing has been presented to the mayor and board of commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, signed by over sixty (60%) per cent of the property owners of the tract of land therein described and designated as ADAMS ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said tract of land being in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and lying contiguous to and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, which petition prays that seid Board annex to said City of Tulsa, said Tract of land, and,
