

SECTION 1. That a tract of land hereinafter described, the same being known as ADAMS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF TULSA, Oklahoma, and adjoining the present corporate limits of said City, being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning 1320' south and 360' east of the northwest corner of Section 36, Township 20 North, Range 12 East, thence east parallel with the north line of said section 36, a distance of 300'; thence south parallel with the west line of Section 36, 1320'; thence west 300' to the C. L. of Detroit Avenue, thence north with the C. L. of Detroit Avenue 1320' to the point of beginning, being that part of Adams Addition not already in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

be and the same is hereby annexed to said City of Tulsa, to be known as ADAMS ADDITION to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City, be, and the same are hereby extended to include the above described tract of land provided, however, that the said tract of land is admitted to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, upon the condition and subject to the granting of a perpetual easement by the owners of said tract of land to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, giving to the City of Tulsa, a perpetual right and easement to enter upon and use any portion of the above described tract of land and to build, construct, lay, maintain, alter or repair any sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines and any other public utilities and the said right of perpetual easement covering all of said tract of land is hereby accepted by the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Section 2. That from and after this ordinance takes effect the real estate described in Section 1, hereof, shall be a part of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately, and approved, this 6th day of November, 1923.
