hundred and thirty-two (132) feet to the Northwest corner thereof; thence East along the North line of said Lot 4 a distance of one hundred and sixty (160) feet; thence South along a straight line a distance of one hundred and thirty-two (132) feet to a point on the South line of said Lot 4; thence West along the South line of said Lot 4, a distance of one hundred COMPARED and sixty (160) feet to the point of beginning:

be and the same is hereby added to and annexed to the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the corporate limits of said City be and the same hereby are extended to include said tract of land for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereby retains and reserves a perpetual easement and right to enter upon and use any portion of the above described tract of land and to build construct, lay, maintain, alter or repair any sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, telegraph lines, electric lines or any other public utilities.

SECTION 3. That from and after this ordin nce takes effect the real estate described in Section 1, hereof, shall be a part of the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and all persons residing therein and all property situated thereon, shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all repsects and particulars to the jurisdiction, control and laws and ordinances of said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 4. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
