ORDINANCE NO. 2556.

An Ordinance adding and annexing to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a certain tract of land within Tulsa County, Oklahoma ^{described} as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on the South line of and two hundred and eighty (280) feet East of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 12, Township 19-North; Range 12-East; thence North along a straight line a distance of one hundred and fifty (150) feet; thence East along a line parallel to and one hundred and fifty (150) feet North of the South line of said Section 12 a distance of one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 3 Boulder Park Addition to the city of Tulsa Oklahoma, according to the official plat thereof; thence South along the West line of Main street a distance of one hundred and fifty (150) feet to the South line of said Section 12; thence West along said South line of Section 12 a distance of one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to the point of beginning and declaring an emergency.
