SECTION 2. That from and after the passage of this ordinance, all of the above and foregoing property heretofore described be declared to be parts of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma; that all persons residing therein shall be and are hereby declared to be subject in all respects and particulars to the jurisdiction and control, laws and ordinances of the said City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health and safety, by reason thereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage approval and publication.

PASSED; and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved this 14th day of January, 1919.

A strip of ground, not to exceed ten (10) feet in width being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The West ten (10) feet of Lot 16, Block 8, Woodward Park Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the duly recorded plat thereof.
