the heirs at law of John P. Grass, deceased, and constituting all of the persons entitled to partisipate in the distribution of his estate; and that all of the moneys in the hands of said administrator after the payment of the costs and expenses of administration, be distributed in equal shares to the heirs above named.

That upon making such distribution and taking and filing in this Court proper vouchers showing such distribution that the administration of said estate be deemed closed, and said Ernest Grass as such administrator discharged and the sureties on his official bond discharged from all further liability thereon.
