It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, that the title and possession of said plaintiff in the said premises be, and the same is hereby forever settled and quieted in the plaintiffs as against all claims or demands by the said defendants, and those claiming or to claim under them, or any of them; that the mortgage from Walter Short and Minnis L. Short to Fornia Hickman and J. B. Hickman, dated April 19th 1910, recorded in Book 57 and page 571 of the mortgage records of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby cancelled, and removed as clouds on the title of the estate of Laura B. Williams. deceased, and the said Claude Wilson, in and to the said described premises. And it is further ordered, decreed and adjuired, that said defendants, Fornia Eickman and J. B. Hickman, and those claiming through by or under them or either of them, be, and they are hereby perpetually enjoined and forbidden to claim any right, title, interest or estate, in or to stand premises by virtue of said mortgage, hostile or adverse to the possession and title of plaintiff herein; and said defendant and those claiming under them, are hereby perpetually forbidden and enjoined from commencing any suit to distrub the said plaintiffs in their possession and title to said premises and from distrubing plaintiff in any manner COMESTIMAN in their peacable and quiet enjoyment of said premises.


