homa, parties of the second part, the following described real estate and premises, in  
Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The South West Quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>) of Section Twenty-eight (28) and the East Half (E<sup>1</sup>)  
of the West Half (W<sup>1</sup>) of Section Thirty-three (33) all in Township Nineteen (19)  
North Range Eleven (11) East of the Indian Meridian, containing Three-Hundred-  
Twenty (320) acres more or less.

with all improvements thereon and appurtenances thereunto belonging and warrant the title to the same. This mortgage is given to secure the principal sum of Five-Thousand & No/100 (\$5000.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of five per centum per annum, from date, payable semi-annually, according to the terms of one certain promissory note, signed by the above parties, and described as follows, to-wit:

Dated Tulsa, Oklahoma, February 6th, 1924, for the sum of Five-Thousand & No/100 (\$5000.00) Dollars, payable Feb. 15th, 1929 to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, or their order, at the office of the said Commissioners in the Capitol of said State, and bearing interest from date at rate of five (5) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, on the 15th day of February and August of each year until paid, which interest is evidenced by ten coupon interest notes of even date herewith and executed by said parties of the first part, one (the first) for \$131.25 due on the fifteenth day of August 1924, and nine notes for \$125.00 each, one due on the fifteenth day of February, and one due on the fifteenth day of August of each year until all are paid. Notice of demand, presentment, non-payment, protest, notice of protest and appraisal waived. On default in the payment of principal and interest, or either, when due and payable, the whole of said amount to become due and payable. It is agreed that the parties of the first part, may, at any time before maturity thereof, pay the whole of said debt, principal and interest, or may partially discharge same by the payment of \$100.00, or any multiple thereof.
