NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of said lessees and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, does hereby sell, transfer, assign and convey One Ninth (1/9) undivided working interest of all his rights, title and interest and a One Ninth (1/9) of the right, title and interest of the original lessees in and to said leases and rights thereunder, together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith, to Irene Locke, her executor, administrators, heirs and assigns, and for the same consideration the undersigned, for himself, his successors and assigns, that he is the lawful owner of said leases and all rights and interests thereunder and all of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith, and that he has the good right and authority to sell the same.
