RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of August 1920 Robert D. Boyd and Elizabeth C. Boyd husband and wife, of Pawhuska, Oklahoma, made, executed and delivered to the Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, for the use and benefit of the State of Oklahoma, one certain note for the sum of: Two Thousand and No/100 (\$2000.00) Dollars, secured by a real estate mortgage on all of the following described real property situated in Tulsa County, to-wit:

NOW THEREFORE, Under and by virtue of the above resolution, the Commissioners of the Land Office by their Chairman and Secretary for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, in consideration of value received, do hereby acknowledge full payment and complete satisfaction of the mortgage above described, and do hereby release and discharge said land from the lien of said mortgage.
