- 9. If the estate of either party hereto is assigned, and the prvilege of assigning in whole or in part is hereby expressly allowed, the covenants hereof shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns of the parties hereto; but no change in the ownership of the said land or assignment of rentals or royralties shall be binding on the said Bunn Harris, until after he has been furnished with a written transfer or assignment, or a true copy thereof.
