NO. 250826 - NRS ASSIGNMENT OF OIL & GAS LEASE. COMPARED

WHEREAS, On the 23rd. day of February, 1912, J.J. Donahoe & J.L. Donahoe made, executed and delivered to one E.M. Lowe a certain oil and gas mining lease covering the following described land in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

AND, Whereas, on the 17th. day of April, 1913, a certain oil and gas mining lease was made and entered into by and between E.L. Donahoe, J.J. Donahoe and J.L. Donahoe, Lessor and A.H. Black, J.A. Sivals, W.G. Bryson and E.F. Black, Lessee, covering the following described land in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
