Upon termination of this trust by expiration of the time prescribed for its existence,  
or as provided herein, the trustees herein shall have no power as such except to liquidate the  
affairs of the association and dispose of the trust property in such manner as the Board of  
Trustees shall determine, to the shareholders in due proportion to the shares held by each.
