

My said Trustee is further authorized to pay all taxes, charges and costs of administration and other necessary expenses incurred in the administration, preservation and protection of the property held in this trust, all at such times and to such persons and at such places as shall be proper, lawful and expedient. I expressly direct that said Trustee shall have the power of determination how all receipts and disbursements shall be credited, charged or appropriated as between income and principal and the decision of my Trustee shall be final and not subject to question by the beneficiaries of the trust herein created.

THIRD. This trust is created for the use and benefit of my brother, Samuel W. Misener of Drumright, Oklahoma, and his wife, Mary Misener, and my brother James E. Misener, of Susanville, California, and for my two daughters Genevieve Misener Moore and Lillian J. Misener, both of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

FOURTH: I direct that there shall be paid to my brother Samuel E. Misener, of Drumright Oklahoma, the sum of Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars per month, which payment shall commence on April 1st 1924, and Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars on the first day of each month thereafter during his life time, That upon his death, if his wife, Mary Misener, survives him this payment of Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars per month shall be made to her during her life time.

I direct that there shall be paid to my brother, James E. Misener, of Susanville California, the sum of Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars per month, which payment shall commence on April 1st 1924 and Seventy (\$70.00) Dollars on the first day of each month thereafter, during his life time.

The above payments to be made by my Trustee out of any funds in its hands, either income or principal, and when all funds in the hands of the Trustee have been exhausted, the above payments shall cease.

481 That as and when each of my brothers above named die, and upon the death of Mary Misener, I direct that the funeral and burial expenses of each of them shall be paid by my said Trustee out of any funds in its hands; which payment shall be a charge against this trust. That a suitable marker for each of their graves shall also be paid for by the Trustee herein out of this fund. Provided that the amount of said burial and funeral expenses and cost of said markers shall first be approved by my said Trustee.

FIFTH: That upon the death of the last survivor of Samuel E. Misener and his wife, Mary Misener, and my brother James E. Misener, I direct that my said Trustee shall distribute all of the property, money, credits and securities in this trust to my two daughters, Genevieve Misener Moore and Lillian J. Misener, equally share and share alike.

In the event of the death of either one or both of my said daughters before final distribution of this trust to them, then the portion of this trust that would go to said deceased daughter shall be distributed to her heirs at law according to the laws of descent and distribution in force in the State of Oklahoma at the time of her death.

SIXTH, I hereby expressly direct that the beneficiaries under this trust are hereby restrained from and shall be without right, power or authority to sell, transfer, pledge, mortgage, hypothecate, alienate, anticipate or in any other manner affect or impair his, her or their beneficial and legal rights under this trust during the entire term hereof, or any portion of the same, nor shall this trust be subject to the rights or claims of any creditors of said beneficiaries, nor shall the same be liable to any process of law, and the income from this trust shall be transferable, payable and deliverable solely and exclusively to the above designated beneficiaries and then only at the time entitled to take the same under the terms of this trust, and the personal receipts of the designated beneficiaries hereunder shall be a condition precedent to the payment or delivery of the same to each beneficiary by said Trustee.
