AGREEMENT:

TO CLOSE UP AND DISCONTINUE THE BUSINESS HERETOFORE KNOWN AS CLIPSON
CLEANING AN EXPRESS TRUST;

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS;

That, WHEREAS? the undersigned, P. C. Clipson Louise C. Clipson, and C. E. Neil are
all the persons beneficially interested in the business heretofore conducted and carried on
at the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, under the firm name and style of Clipson Cleaning Works, and
express trust, and

WHEREAS, the said business in an express trust declared, established and organized
as provided by law and the said P. C. Clipson and C. E. Neil are the sole trustees of said
business and trust estate;; and

WHEREAS, it is desire of all said premises that said business be discontinued and
finally closed up; and,

WHEREAS, it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties that the beneficial
interest, property and assets of said Clipson Cleaning Works is owned by said parties, in the
following proportions, to-wit; Louise C. Clipson, 90% thereof, P. C. Clipson 5% thereof, and
C. E. Neil 5% thereof,

NOW THEREFORE IT is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the
said trustees of the said Clipson Cleaning Works shall forthwith transfer all the property and
assets of said Clipson Cleaning Works, an express trust, to said Louise C. Clipson, to be
owned, held and controlled by her as she shall see fit, as her own personal and individual
property and it is further agreed and understood that, when said transfer of said property
shall have been made to the said Louise C. Clipson, as herein provided, the said company and
business, heretofore conducted and carried on in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and known as the
Clipson Cleaning Works, an express trust, shall thereupon terminate and the said business shall
be considered finally closed and the said trust agreement, under which said business was or -
ganized, conducted and carried on, shall terminate and be of no further force or effect,
