WHEREAS, the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 16ht day of June, 1902 and was duly placed on file; and

WHEREAS, said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding impropements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS, the said commission has awarded the real estate described herinbelow to David Goyett who has paid Six Hundred and Ninety-two doll ars the full amount of the purchase price, into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Cherokee Nation of Indians with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee, Indian Territory, and is therefore, entitled to a patent;

NOW THEREFORE, I the undersigned, the Princiapi Chief of the Cherokee Nation, do by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of Congress of the United States hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said David Goyett his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, aforesaid, in and to Lots numbered 1, 10, 12, and 13, in Block numbered 37; Lots Numbered 9 and 10 in Block Numbered 38 and Lot Numbered 1 in Block Numbered 52, in the Town pf Collinsville, Okla., formerly Cherokee Eation, Indian Territory, and according to the pl at thereof on file as aforesaid,
