THIS DEED, Made and entered in to this 24th, day of March, 1924 by and between COSDEN & COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, first part, and ST. LOUIS* SAN FRANCISCO RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, second party,

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WITNESS; That the said first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), to wit in hand paid, the receipt whereof, in hereby acknowledged, does by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said second party, its successors and assigns, the certain strip or parcel of land lying, being and situate in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Nineteen (19), North, Range Twelve (12) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, said strip of parcel being Seventeen (17) feet in width, that is to say Eight and Five Tenths (8.5) feet on each side of the following described center line,

Beginning at the end of last described course in deed from Cosden & D. W. M. Company to St. Louis-San Francisco Railway Company dated March 2nd, 1923 recorded in Book Four Hundred Thirty Five (435), Page Two Hundred Ninety One (291). April 16th, 1923, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Records; thence northerly along the continuation of said course a distance of One Hundred Three (103) feet to the end, Containing, 0.04 acres, more or less;

To Have and To Hold the premises aforesaid unto the said second party and unto its successors and assigns forever,

It is understood that the premises herein conveyed are to be used as and for railroad right of way and all other purposes, incidental to railroad uses, and if and when abandoned for such purposes, the same shall revert to the Grantor hereon, In the event of an abandonment, or a reversion hereunder, the Railway Company, shall have the right, within a reasonable time to take up and remove all materials entering into the construction of the track upon the within described premises,
