W. L. Briggs, being first duly sworn, upon oath deposes and says that he was formerly the executor of the estate of Pearl M. Wheatly, deceased, and that the said Pearl M. Wheatley was at the time of her death the owner of the

Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27)
Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Ten (10), East,
situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,

That on August 30, 1919 Pearl M. Wheatly executed an oil and gas mining lease on the property above described in favor of the Jane Guinn Oil Company, a corporation, of Tulsa Oklahoma, for a term of three (3) years from that date and as long thereafter as oil or gas or either of them should be produced from the land by the lessee or its assigns; that affiant is familiar with the above described property and has been on and over the same and knows of his own knowledge that no well was ever drilled on said land or any part thereof under the lease above described and that no oil or gas has ever been produced from said land under said lease, and that the same has terminated and expired and is no longer in force or effect.
