#261414 EC COMPARED ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE;

On the 27th, day of December, 1923. a certain oil and gas mining lease was entered into by and between Ollie Crossley, Executrix of the Estate of Isaiah S. Crossley, deceased, and Eddie Crossley as lessors, to Glenn W. Jones, Lessee, covering the production of Oil and gas on the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East. except the Midland Valley Railroad right-of-way and excepting the Prairie Pipe Line right-of way to lay pipe line theretofore granted, said land containing forty (40) acres more or less; and excepting one-eighth part of the oil and gas, gasoline and casinghead gas produced and saved from said premises, to be delivered in the pipe line with which the wells might be connected which lease was duly recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in record book 474. page 486.

And on the 5th. day of June 1924 said Glenn W. Jones executed an assignment of said oil and gas lease to O. N. West, which lease was recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds on March 14- 1924 in Record Book 478. Page 161.

Now on this 23 day of June, 1924, the said O. N. West for One Dollar and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does bargain, sell, transfer, assign and convey unto K. V. Fusselman all his right, title and interest in and to the production of oil and gas, gasoline and casinghead gas on said premises under said lease and assignment thereof, and this grantor states, that he does own seven-eighths, of the working interest of said oil, gas, gasoline and casinghead gas, but that he does not own one-eighth part of the working interest of the said lease, but that said one-eighth part is supposed to belong to M. M. Breckenridge of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

And for the consideration aforesaid the said O. N. West for himself, his heirs, successors and representatives, does covenant with the said assignee, K. V. Fusselman, that he is the lawful owner of said lease and the rights and interests thereunder with the exception aforesaid which is supposed to belong to M. A. Breckenridge and that said West has good right and authority to sell and convey his said rights and interests as aforesaid and that his said rights, interest and property aforesaid are free and clear of liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid;
