

the business aforesaid: that said Rainbow Oil Company will keep an accurate account of the daily receipts and business transacted, and will, as far as possible, allocate said expenses to the proper branch of the business.

(7) It is agreed between the parties that the third party, or whomsoever it may designate, shall have full and free access to the books of the company and all data and memoranda concerning the daily transactions of the business of said company.

(8) It is agreed between the parties that the said Rainbow Oil Company and James H. Chenault, as trustee for the third party, may continue the collection of the assigned accounts, and deposit the same in the Exchange National Bank to the account in which deposits and proceeds of the business have heretofore been deposited, and shall proceed to check on said account and pay the necessary running and overhead expenses of said business, and pay such sums as can safely be spared to Wilcox & Company or other pressing creditors, but it is understood and agreed between the parties that first and second parties shall not divert said funds for any other purposes and shall not pay out any large or substantial sums without the consent of the third party.

9. The parties of the third part agree with the parties of the first and second part that they will extend to the Rainbow Oil Company a line of credit not exceeding Four Thousand Dollars (\$4000.00); said third party agreeing to sell gasoline as needed from time to time, and so sell the same to the party of the first part at the market price F. O. B. refinery plus one-half cent ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢) a gallon, and the first party agrees to pay for same at said price in the usual course of business, for the payment of which gasoline these presents have also been and are executed.
