THIS INDENTURE, Made the 4th day of January 1924, by and between EXCHANGE TRUST COMPANY a Corporation, of Tulsa, Oklahoma the duly appointed qualified, and acting Administrator with the will annexed of the estate of W. A. Greenwood deceased, party of the first part, and Dan LaFollette, of Tulsa, Oklahoma party of the second part, witnesseth;
