WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$150 Canceled Fifteen Hundred and Nondollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma to ;wit- Lot One (11), Block Fifty (50) Original town of Collinsville Oklahoma,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, on in anywise appertaining forever,
