RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION relinquishing reservation of easements for sanitary sewers of the alley between Lots 11- 12- 13- 14- 15- 16- 17- 18- 19- 20- and 21 on west side and Lots 5- 6- 7- 8- 9- 10- on East side of same, all in Block 7 Buena Vista Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, said addition according to the plat thereof filed on the 10th day of October 1908 in the office of the Registrar of Deeds of Tulsa County in Book 1, Page 14- A, and the alley between Lot 4, on the south side and Lots 11- 12- 13- 14- 15 on the north side, all in Block 7, Buena Vista Park Addition according to the plat filed in the office of the United States Clerk at Sapulpa Indian Territory on the 2nd day of June, 1906, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, under date of July 7th, 1916, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma by Ordinance No 1539, vacated all of the alleys in Block 7, Buena Vista Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, reserving and retaining the sanitary sewer easement therein and thereunder as described in said ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of said City that there is no longer any necessity for retaining and reserving said sanitary easement in so far as the same covers or affects the alley between Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 on the East side and Lots 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21 on the west side, all in Block 7, said addition according to the plat thereof, filed on the 10th day of October, 1908, in the office of the Registrar of Deed of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in Book 1, Page 14-A, and the alley between Lot 4, on the south side and Lots 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 on the North side all in Block 7, Buena Vista Park Addition, according to the plat filed in the office of the United States Clerk at Sapulpa, Indian Territory on the 2nd day of June, 1906, and it further appears that permanent improvements have been heretofore built and constructed over certain portions of said described alleys, and

WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners that the said sanitary sewer so reserved and retained should be relinquished.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1; That the sanitary sewer easement reserved and retained under and by virtue of Ordinance 1539 of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma on and under all the alleys in Block 7, Buena Vista Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, be relinquished and released in so far as the same covers the above described portions of such alleys as were in existence at the date of the passage adoption and approval of said ordinance.

SECTION 2. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the Public Health, peace and safety by reason whereof, this Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
