It is my earnest desire and wish that my said adopted son take at least four (4) years work at the University of Kansas, and longer if he so desires. I desire he shall have every advantage that his allowance will afford, that he qualify himself for a good and useful profession or business career; that he choose as his companions, friends and associates, only those of a high mental, moral and business standing and that he be always honorable, upright and trustworthy, loving God and his fellowmen.

Sixth;-- I nominate, constitute and appoint Mr. W. L. Biggs of Muskogee, Oklahoma, executor of this, my last will and testament. In the event of the death, refusal or inability to act of the said W. L. Biggs, either as trustee or executor of my estate, I nominate and appoint Ezra Brainerd, Jr., of Muskogee, Oklahoma, trustee and executor in his place and stead. Neither of the persons above named shall be required to give any bond or security for the proper discharge of their duties, however, I desire that any successor appointed by the Court shall be required to give bond for the faithful performance of his duties, as required by law.

Seventh;--I hereby revoke all former or other Wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made.
